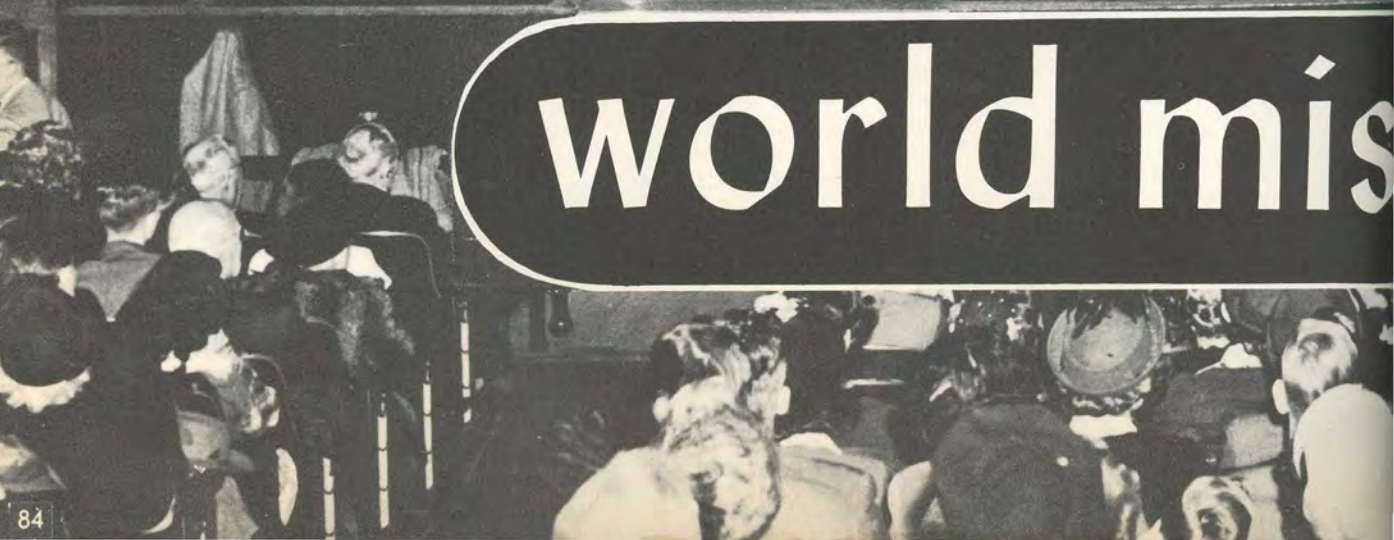
world missions night
