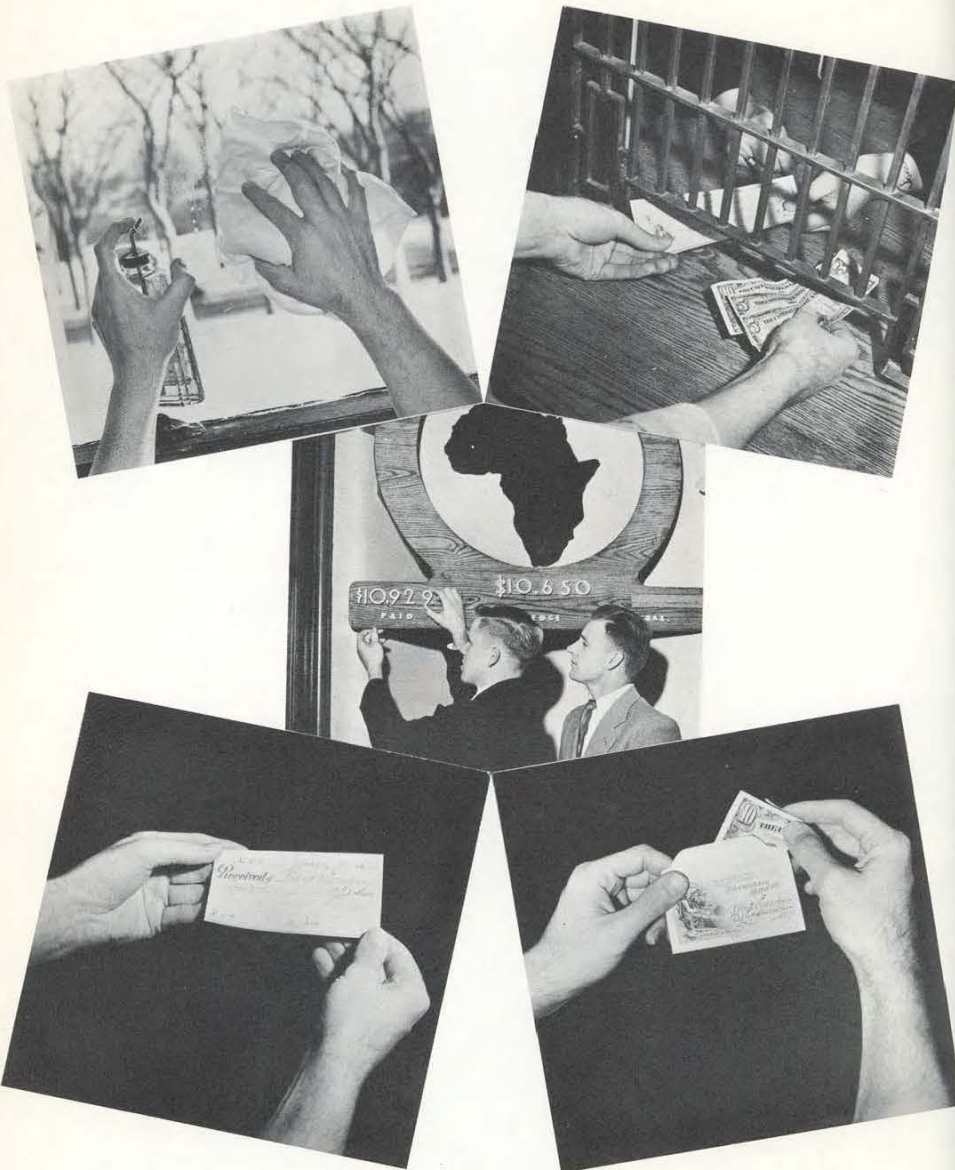
The tract committee represents an important phase of Christian service. Each week they fold several thousand tracts which are used on Christian service assignments as well as in daily contacts.

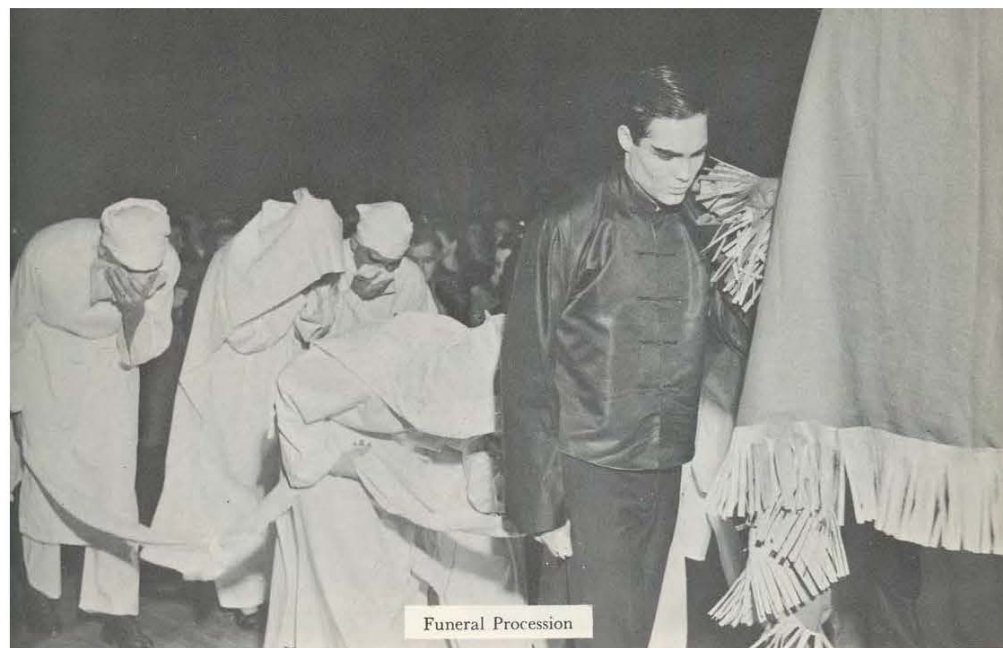
