Till the cross leads upward To the blood-bought crown.

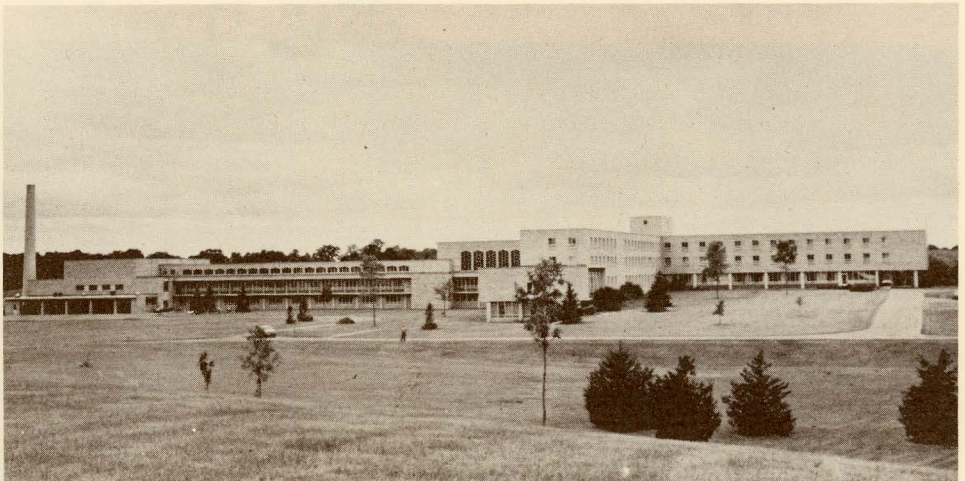
GOD OF OUR FATHERS

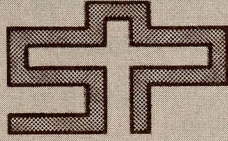
Warren

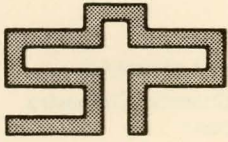
Though SPBC is the midwestern regional college of The Christian and Missionary Alliance, it is interdenominational in scope with many groups represented in the student body of more than 400 young people.

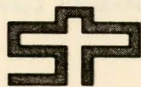
