OVERTURE

RECITATIVE (Tenor) Comfort ye, comfort ye my people, saith your God; speak ye comfortably to Jerusalem; and cry unto her, that her warfare is accomplished, that her iniquity is pardoned. The voice of him that crieth in the wilderness: Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make straight in the desert a highway for our God.--Isaiah 40:1-3

AIR (Tenor) Every valley shall be exalted, and every mountain and hill made low, the crooked straight and the rough places plain.--Isaiah 40:4

CHORUS And the glory of the Lord shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together, for the mouth of the Lord hath spoken. --Isaiah 40:5

RECITATIVE (Bass) Thus saith the Lord of hosts: Yet once a little while and I will shake the heavens and the earth, the sea and the dry land; and I will shake all nations; and the desire of all nations shall come. The Lord, whom ye seek, shall suddenly come to His temple, even the messenger of the covenant, whom ye delight in: behold, He shall come, saith the Lord of hosts.--Haggai 2:6,7; Malachi 3:1

AIR (Bass) But who may abide the day of His coming, and who shall stand when He appeareth? For He is like a refiner's fire.--Malachi 3:2

CHORUS And He shall purify the sons of Levi, that they may offer unto the Lord an offering in righteousness.--Malachi 3:3

RECITATIVE (Alto) Behold, a virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and shall call His name Emmanuel, God with us.--Isaiah 7:14, Matthew 1:23

AIR (Alto) AND CHORUS O thou that tellest good tidings to Zion, get thee up into the high mountain, O thou that tellest good tidings to Jerusalem, lift up thy voice with strength; lift it up, be not afraid; say unto the cities of Judah: Behold your God! AIR (Soprano) Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, the King cometh unto thee! He is the righteous Savior, and He shall speak peace unto the heathen.--Zechariah 9:9, 10

RECITATIVE (Alto) Then shall the eyes of the blind be opened, and the ears of the deaf unstopped; then shall the lame man leap as an hart, and the tongue of the dumb shall sing.--Isaiah 35:5, 6

AIR (Alto) He shall feed His flock like a shepherd; and He shall gather the lambs with His arm, and carry them in His bosom, and gently lead those that are with young.--Isaiah 40:11

AIR (Soprano) Come unto Him, all ye that labour and are heavy laden and He will give you rest. Take his yoke upon you, and learn of Him, for He is meek and lowly of heart, and ye shall find rest unto your souls.--Matthew 11:28,29

CHORUS He trusted in God that He would deliver Him; let Him deliver Him, if He delight in Him.--Psalm 22:8

RECITATIVE (Tenor) Thy rebuke hath broken His heart; He is full of heaviness. He looked for some to have pity on Him, but there was no man; neither found He any to comfort Him.--Psalm 69:20

AIR (Tenor) He was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of Thy people was He stricken.--Isaiah 53:8

RECITATIVE (Tenor) But thou didst not leave His soul in hell; nor didst Thou suffer Thy Holy One to see corruption.--Psalm 16:10

CHORUS Lift up your heads, O ye gates; and be ye lift up, ye everlasting doors; and the King of glory shall come in. Who is the King of glory? The Lord strong and mighty, the Lord mighty in battle. Lift up your heads, O ye gates, and be ye lift up, ye everlasting doors; and the King of glory shall come in. Who is the King of glory? The Lord of Hosts, He is the King of glory.--Psalm 24:7-10

CHORUS The Lord gave the word: great was the company of the preachers. --Psalm 65:11

AIR (Soprano) How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things.--Romans 10:15

CHORUS Their sound is gone out into all lands, and their words unto the ends of the world.--Romans 10:18

AIR (Bass) Why do the nations so furiously rage together? Why do the people imagine a vain thing? The kings of the earth rise up, and the rulers take counsel together against the Lord, and against His Anointed.--Psalm 2:1,2

CHORUS Hallelujah! For the Lord God Omnipotent reigneth. The kingdom of this world is become the Kingdom of our Lord, and of His Christ; and He shall reign for ever and ever. King of Kings, and Lord of Lords. Hallelujah!--Revelation 19:6,11:15,19:16
